Hi all, like the other guy in the other thread, I'm having some problems installing yum on one of my VE via vzyum.

Any ideas? My VE is running on Centos 4 Default OSTemplate.

I'm able to yum just fine on the host machine though.

```
[root@radiowave rpm]# vzyum 401 install yum
exec /usr/bin/yum -c /vz/template/centos/4/i386/config/yum.conf --installroot /v
z/root/401 install yum
```

There was a problem importing one of the Python modules
required to run yum. The error leading to this problem was:

```
/usr/share/vzpkgtools/vzrpm43/lib/python2.4/site-packages/rpmmodule.so: wrong
ELF class: ELFCLASS32
```

Please install a package which provides this module, or
verify that the module is installed correctly.

It's possible that the above module doesn't match the
current version of Python, which is:
2.4.3 (#1, May 24 2008, 13:57:05)
[GCC 4.1.2 20070626 (Red Hat 4.1.2-14)]
