IMHO ,in general ,each distribution should support logging the init boot process to some file. With openrc you can set rc\_logger="YES" and it should log the init boot output to /var/log/rc.log (Similar to baselayout-1\* with RC\_BOOTLOG="yes" in /etc/rc.conf and app-admin/showconsole installed.)

However it looks like (at least for me) setting rc\_logger="YES" does not work with openrc and openvz combination. I'd be glad if you can check it /var/log/rc.log is created then you set rc\_logger="YES" in /etc/rc.conf in VE with openrc installed, so that i could report this bug in openrc as a common problem for all openvz+openrc users.
