I think that you should change \$CTID to \$VEID
in all your custom scripts. Probably the naming scheme has changed
with vzctl versions newer than 3.0.22 from VE to CT.

This is what i've setup

```
#!/bin/bash

CONFIGFILE=/etc/vz/conf/$VEID.conf
. $CONFIGFILE
VZHOSTIF=`echo $NETIF |sed 's/^.*host_ifname=\(.*\),.*$/\1/g'`

if [ ! -n "$VZHOSTIF" ]; then
    echo "According to $CONFIGFILE VE$VEID has no veth interface configured."
    exit 1
fi
if [ ! -n "$BRIDGEDEV" ]; then
    echo "According to $CONFIGFILE VE$VEID veth interface is not enslaved to any bridge."
    exit 1
fi

ifconfig veth${VEID}.0 0
brctl addif ${BRIDGEDEV} veth${VEID}.0
exit $? 
```
