You could do it via chkconfig utility.

When I executed "service vz start" nothing was happening

What does it mean "nothing"? Did command return with success or with error message or anything?

Quote:

I deleted any references to the init scripts containing reference to vz with the hopes of recreating the init scripts by re-installing the RPM.

It's not clear if you change files from the particular package or from several ones. In extreme case, you can remove vzctl package from your HN and then install it again.

Anyway, exact output messages would be very useful.
