Hello,

you've mentioned that your VE had an IP address 10.10.0.3 but \$VEID.conf doesn't contain any information about this in IP\_ADDRESS field. So, have you removed that IP address from conf file or just used "vzctl --ipdel ..." command when your VE was stoped? If yes, there is a bug [http://bugzilla.openvz.org/show\\_bug.cgi?id=478](http://bugzilla.openvz.org/show_bug.cgi?id=478) which might be related with your situation. Please, delete ip address from venet interface when VE is started.

If you're planning to get rid of venet interface you should unload vznetdev module from HN but you can bump into some unexpective things [http://forum.openvz.org/index.php?t=msg&goto=32140&&srch=venet+module#msg\\_32140](http://forum.openvz.org/index.php?t=msg&goto=32140&&srch=venet+module#msg_32140) we know about this issue and it should be fixed but check it with the kernel you are using now.
