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it is a function of the firewall that ships with the paid product but it is not present in openVZ

apf installed on the HN can be configured with unique iptables rules on an IP basis, very flexible solution http://kb.parallels.com/article_130_875_en.html (note the IFACE and MONKERN settings are the same for HN as they are for CT)

caution: not all iptables modules are available for openVZ kernel and what there is happens to be buggy e.g. configure your conntrack settings with vz STOPPED or you get a kernel oops. the solution above for apf inside a CT does not work on the latest kernel and latest version of vz (at least i cant get it to work ... i have it working on older kernels and vz versions)
