Quote:OpenVZ patch itself is 99.99% platform independent, so there should be no much problems to make it work. If you have such a possibility we can help you with it.

Thats what I was hoping to hear, and very pleased to hear that the platform independence was not compromised with the OpenVZ patch to the kernel source. With this in mind, I should be able to build it myself with minimal if any tweaking of source code.
