Hi,

I want to substitute one of my virtual servers, so the new one get the old ones information; container id, hostname, ip etc.

I read in this thread: <http://forum.openvz.org/index.php?t=msg&goto=29069&>

That I should do this:

```
host# vzctl chkpnt 101 --dumpfile /tmp/Dump.101
host# mv /etc/vz/conf/101.conf /etc/vz/conf/102.conf
host# mv /vz/private/101 /vz/private/102
host# mv /vz/root/101 /vz/root/102
host# vzctl restore 102 --dumpfile /tmp/Dump.101
```

But when I do:

```
vzctl chkpnt 101 --dumpfile /tmp/Dump.101
```

I get thsi error:

```
Setting up checkpoint...
```

```
    suspend...
```

```
    dump...
```

```
Can not dump container: Invalid argument
```

```
Error: iptables-save exited with 255
```

```
Checkpointing failed
```

The /var/log/vzctl.log also just tells me that it can't dump the container, but not why?
