Once we start to use the VE's (start up an additional process in each VE), we begin to see processes "disappear"

What does it mean disappear?

Does the process you've started last disappear/terminate?

Please, check logs. Is there anything there?

Quote:

I am pretty sure that the OOM killer is shutting down processes (bean counters in the VE tells us so) but the best that I can tell, there is plenty of "free" memory in both the VE's and on the host.

We cannot be fully confident that it was OOM killer.

If user_beancounters show fail counters you should increase appropriate resources.

Quote:

It seems like maybe it is the hosts OOM killer and not one in the VE but I don't know how to verify that.

If OOM killer did something you should be able to observe it in logs. Please check dmesg on the HN.
