Hello,

ifconfig eth2 mtu 9000 prompts me an error:  
SIOCSIFMTU: Invalid argument

The same NIC's are running with MTU 9000 at my SAN clusters. I'm using a selfmade SAN: the storage nodes are based on FreeNas, running in synchronous mode on different buildings as HA cluster.

A value of MTU 7000 will be accepted by the NIC on OpenVZ, so I'm thinking, the OVZ kernel / driver combination should be the problem. That's why I'm interesting in getting informations about the NIC driver in the actual kernel.
