for example vzdump-VEID-%Y-%m-%d-%H-%M-%s.tar.gz

It seems fairly straight foward

On a side note, I think a nifty upgrade for vzdump would be for it to allow users to append a label. For example, vzdump 101 -L my\_special\_backup would spit out a file called vzdump-101-my\_special\_backup.tar.gz

Dont get sidetracked by my feature request, the real question is how can I edit the vzdump code jus to get a datestamp for now. The line that needs to be changed is 1287.

my \$basename = "vzdump-\${vpsid}";
