Clean debian installation of kernel 2.6.18-6 works fine.

But, if I install:

fzakernel-2.6.18-686-bigmem

which should resemble original kernel distro, then it doesn't work

I am really stuck with this one...

Maybe if we approach it like this:

```
nononsense:~# uname -a
```

```
Linux nononsense 2.6.18-openvz-18-53.5d1-686 #1 SMP Sat Mar 22 19:27:07 CET 2008 i686  
GNU/Linux
```

Loads up, all seems oke, tho' raid controller is unknown, but no crashing
OpenVZ and all can be installed.

If I could now get my hands on this kernel, to compile it with 64GB support...?
