This patch is applicable to vanilla Linux 2.6.8 kernel (which can be obtained from kernel.org) to form the OpenVZ kernel.

Quote:Kernel configs

Official configs of this OpenVZ kernel used to build binary RPMS.

So, to get sources of openVZ you should obtain vanilla kernel and apply openVZ patch to it. To build kernel from these sources use appropriate config file.
