venet0 on the HN doesn't contain any ip address.

Quote:

And the system routes the packets automatically to the appropriate interface on VE0?

After "--netif\_add" command is invoked an additional route appears on the HN which points to venet0 interface.

Quote:

So venet works only if the VE0 is in the same subnet as the VEs
