Your workaround didn't work probably because you have copy-pasted the /proc/swaps content. This replaces tabs with spaces -- so in order to fix it properly do not use copy/paste.

Proper solution is to use RHEL5-based (i.e. stable) kernel \geq 028stab060.2 and vzctl \geq 3.0.24. Since vzctl-3.0.24 is not yet released you have to use the one from git repo.

It adds a new parameter called --swappages, which is described in vzctl(man page. Here's the link to man page diff:
