You can get the memory page size of the computer with:

```
getconf PAGE_SIZE
```

In Bash you can show the complete calculation for how many pages are 256MB with:

```
echo $((($((256 * 1024)) / $($getconf PAGE_SIZE / 1024))))
```

But I've found this:

And it seems to be able to modify the VPS memory with (I'm not sure):

```
vzctl set [vpsid] --vmguarpages 256M:257M --save
```
