I have a service I created because I want to run something at shutdown of a VE that saves a ram disk to a real drive. I've set it up with chkconfig and I can start and stop the service manually and everything works. When I start it up everything works but shutting down it doesn't run.

In the `/etc/rc.d/rc0.d` and the `/etc/rc.d/rc6.d` there is a link just like all the other links pointing to the program in the `init.d` directory. Looks just like everything else except it doesn't run.
