Hey,

I have read and followed the instructions of the wiki about the configuration of a virtual ethernet network (veth) and it is working perfectly for my first VPS.

I have set an IP-address in my VPS editing the /etc/network/interfaces file, and I can therefore ping the host or some websites.

I just would like to know why the vzlist command does not return the VPS-IP-Address? vzlist returns CTID, NPROC, STATUS (running) HOSTNAME but nothing for IP\_ADD.

Then, why the host virtual ethernet device disappears when I reboot the VPS?
