the main problem I suppose is that none of the MY\_PC's interfaces know about VLAN existence. To make a route decision on MY\_PC's side we have to pick out a VLAN tag of a network packet but it's impossible because MY\_PC knows nothing about VLAN existence so the network packet is dropped.
