Hello!

I'm using my own self build kernel - i've attached the configuration. But i have the problem that PCI network cards and onboard networkcards randomly change their names. Sometimes the onboard is eth0 sometimes the external one is eth0.

I'm not using udev for network cards (deleted z45\_persistent-net-generator.rules and z25\_persistent-net.rules) cause i hate it that when i put the harddisk in another server or i had to swap the mainboard the missing networkcards in udev do not get replaced instead they get numbers like eth8, eth9 and so on.

Can anybody help?
