1.) If you want to set the time on the hardware node you do not have to care about anything. Just run `ntpdate <ntp-server>` and additionally `hwclock`. Please consult the CentOS manual on how to install `ntpdate` (or use a system that you can handle )

2.) If you want to set the time through a container as explained by me, look up for a PDF called "OpenVZ User's guide". There is a section "Changing System Time from VPS".
