- 1.) If you want to set the time on the hardware node you do not have to care about anything. Just run ntpdate <ntp-server> and additionally hwclock. Please consult the CentOS manual on how to install ntpdate (or use a system that you can handle )
- 2.) If you want to set the time through a container as explained by me, look up for a PDF called "OpenVZ User's guide". There is a section "Changing System Time from VPS".
