Hi.

I've installed OpenVZ on a Gentoo server. I formatted my partitions with EXT4 (production) but I didn't pay attention that the LiveCD was running a recent kernel (2.6.30) for which EXT4 is in production. OpenVZ sources 2.6.27 (brullov), which are marked stable in Gentoo, only include the development version of EXT4 so none of my partitions can be mounted.

Does anyone know if there's a patch to back port ext4 onto 2.6.27 for OpenVZ?

EDIT: I really would like to use EXT4 especially because of the enhancements it provides. However I guess it might be not such a good idea...
