obviously the onboard ethernet adapter had a bug. I deactivated it in the BIOS and installed a pci card. Now only the el5 ovzkernel can boot these disks (no go with 2.6.18, pae or ent). Now a ping to an external domain works if IPTables on the Node is stopped. When IPTables runs, only pinging to ip addresses (not domains) is possible.

Here my configuration:

Node: CentOS 5.4 with 2.6.18-128.2.1.el5.028stab064.7ent

Attached is the sysctl.conf of the node, and the conf file of the container.

working nameserver is set inside of CT (212.40.0.10).
