"Killed" means: Before adding it to the container it is visible with ifconfig as a network interface and after adding it is is gone.

But this is exactly what netdev_dev is intended to do. (man vzctl).

It is possible to create two types of network devices inside VE: venet and veth. The latter is created with help of "--netif_add" option. Moving network devices is also possible with help of "-netdev_add" option. Moving network device means moving it from the HN to VE. http://wiki.openvz.org/Veth
