First, let me start by stating I am fairly new to OpenVZ. Now, last night I tried to use the pre packaged template for Fedora-core-4-default, which worked fine, then I attempted to install vncserver + X11. These installs all seemed to work fine, I did notice that a new fedora kernel was installed. Well, at some point I decided to vzctl restart <vpsid> and it seemed the image started, but I could not access it via ssh or vzctl enter. When hardware 0 reboots it shows OpenVZ starts, but that VPS 101 fails to start.

So any idea how I might set up X11 under a VPS? Also, along the same note, is there a good reference on how to build my own template?
