Hello,

I've a Problem with OpenVZ and Ubuntu Karmic Koala. After i had updated the VE to karmic, i was wondering why cron isnt running. Ive tried /etc/init.d/cron start but it fails with that message: start: Unable to connect to Upstart: Failed to connect to socket /com/ubuntu/upstart: Connection refused

So it seems to be a upstart problem, was my 1st thought. But because the ve is in use, ive created a clone of it for experimenting wit that problem. And that seems to be my 1st luck that day. The new VE fails to start properly!

It seems to have only One process started! Is there any way to find out whats happening with that VE? vzvtl enter is not possible. (no pty)

btw I'm running Ubuntu on a Debian host with vzctl version 3.0.22 and kernel 2.6.26-2-openvz-amd64.
