Hi All,

I'm trying to make a container with only a few directories mounted as RW (/var /usr/local /tmp).

Playing a little with mounts scripts I've got it working remounting all directories with --bind and RO option

But I still have the whole / mounted as RW, so it's possible to create directories and files on the first level (/). How to prevent it?

This trick doesn't work

```
mount -f -oremount,ro -t simfs /v0/vz/private/101 /v0/vz/root/101
```
