I have seen people complaining about this error for literally years now. Every single time they are told "upgrade to the latest kernel". Well, this has been plaguing me on a server over the course of 8 different kernel versions and it has never gone away.

This bug sometimes causes the server load to go out of control, causes network traffic to almost stop, and a number of other things.

This is the error I get in the logs and EVERY time I try to stop a container.
