Thanks. When would you expect these patches to be incorporated into the stable kernel?

Look, the feature you want to be in the kernel is not a widely demanded one. Frankly speaking, I cannot remember the case when it was needed. BUT, that doesn't mean that it will not be included in OpenVZ kernel. First of all. I suggest you to file a new bug report and describe the problem you have. You can also attach the patch I proposed you to use. It helps maintainers to include the feature much faster. Another point I want to note is that if you are running 32-bit VEs on the 64-bit HN and ps(!) complains about huge PID then such a bug MUST BE fixed. And dynamically adjusted pid max values is a possible solution.
