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My main hardware node has a failing disk, so I have setup a new centos 5.4 based hardware node using the latest available OpenVz code.

I have been using VZdump to take nightly backups of my containers to an offsite backup provider.

I have copied the tar files on to the new hw node and attempted to restore them using vzrestore. I get almost identical output on all of my containers:
