Hi,

i've just made a yum-update and updated kernel to

2.6.18-194.3.1.el5.028stab069.5

which gave me some really nice slowdown to USB 2.0 external drive:

```
[root@watcher ~]# hdparm -tT /dev/sda
```

so i get back to the

and got the speed back:
