But I think no matter in which way we install the kernel -- either installing directly from the rpm or compiling from the kernel source, vzkernel and vzquotamod as two essential components, should be generated and installed. But now, after compiling the kernel from the source, when attempting to install the vzquota and vzctl via rpms, it seems vzkernel and vzquotamod are still missing. So I wonder whether vzkernel and vzquotamod are really not generated and installed currently in the system. Thanks.
