So which of the more current kernels are recommended as the most stable? Please, trust me - the most stable kernel at the moment is 2.6.18-194.3.1.el5.028stab069.6 and we honestly do not know any critical issue on it. If your node crashes often - this is a serious bug that we unfortunately missed (and so do other users - you first complain on such an issue), or may be some part of your hardware got broken. But we need logs in order to make more precise diagnose.

i understand that your server is in production, so you cannot just stop it and perform, say, memory testing, but could you check /var/log/mcelog for some hardware logs? Or output of "dmidecode" - somewhere at the end, section "Log events".
