Hi,

I am new to virtualization from the technical side, and this is an old thread, but it seems a good starting point to me

I have the intention to install a Ubuntu 8.04 VPS (CentOS is the host) to host a local Web site for internal testing. At the same time I would like to perform code development for the site on the same VPS (I am too ambitious I know), therefore I need to use an IDE (i.e. IntelliJ, netbeans, ...). Since GUI is mentioned in this thread, my question is: would that be a bad experience from a performance point of view? I mean, would it be slow for the graphical IDE?
If that is doable, what memory allocation is best advisable for that VPS? Any other suggestions, help, advices are welcome.
