Hi

I am currently migrating some hardware nodes to a similar setup. I'm using a Solkenix SoINAS EX as the iSCSI target. The / filesystem resides on a small DAS on the hardware node, while the /vz filesystem resides on the SoINAS which is connected to the hardware node by iSCSI.

To make the hardware node expendable (i.e. if a hardware node dies, we simply replace it with a new hardware node, assign the proper IP address, and configure iSCSI connection parameters; and it's up and running again in a mater of minutes), I moved some directories from / (on the DAS) to /vz (on the SoINAS) and replaced the originals with symlinks to the ones in their new location:

```
/etc/vz -> /vz/etc/vz
```

```
/etc/sysconfig/vz-scripts -> /vz/etc/sysconfig/vz-scripts
```

...so far it's working well.
