have you check the "logrotation" ?

Have you any logs like messages.0 messages.1.gz ...

Seems that every day at 01:44 rsyslogd is restarted, and the logs go to be rotated.

If package logrotate is installed please check the period of logrotation config for rsyslog like /etc/logrotate.d/rsyslog

But in your logs are is a strange entry:
