i found this link on <https://help.ubuntu.com/community/OpenVZ> & was doing exactly what it said.

till i came to this part:

Build the Kernel

```
sudo fakeroot make-kpkg --initrd --append-to-version=-ovz32 --revision=1.0 kernel_image
kernel_headers
```

& i got this error

```
