Not sure what the problem is but can't seem to boot from USB flash. Here's my modprobe.conf

```
options snd-hda-intel index=0
remove snd-hda-intel { /usr/sbin/alsactl store 0 >/dev/null 2>&1 || : ; }; /sbin/modprobe -r
--ignore-remove snd-hda-intel
alias eth0 r8169
#alias eth0 forcedeth
alias scsi_hostadapter libata
alias scsi_hostadapter1 usb-storage
alias scsi_hostadapter2 pata_atiixp
alias scsi_hostadapter3 sata_nv
alias scsi_hostadapter4 ahci
alias snd-card-0 snd-hda-intel
options snd-card-0 index=
```

Boot fails with messages about not finding /dev/root and other file system related failures.

From what I can tell it looks like the USB device isn't initializing in time because after the boot failed message the USB drive attachment message comes up.

What am I missing? Thanks in advance.
