With the latest rhel5 kernel, "iotop now works in both CT0 and in CTs" (

<http://wiki.openvz.org/Download/kernel/rhel5/028stab079.1> )

Awesome! In an Ubuntu 10.04 VE, iotop worked out of the box (i.e. apt-get install iotop).

On the CentOS 5 host, it's a bit trickier but still works:

- 1) Enable EPEL ( [http://fedoraproject.org/wiki/EPEL/FAQ#How\\_can\\_I\\_install\\_the\\_packages\\_from\\_the\\_EPEL\\_software\\_repository.3F](http://fedoraproject.org/wiki/EPEL/FAQ#How_can_I_install_the_packages_from_the_EPEL_software_repository.3F) )
- 2) yum install python-ctypes
- 3) Download latest iotop tar.gz <http://guichaz.free.fr/iotop/> (NOTE: The rpm does NOT work because it complains about too old python)
- 4) Extract and run ./iotop.py
