Hi,

I'm using ProxMox with vzctl 3.0.24 with Gentoo VEs.
I run into some strange behaviour and I don't see how I can correct this, maybe someone could help me.

Here the problem :

Everything works absolutely fine with my VEs but when I want to stop a VE with `vzctl stop CTID`, the container is very very long to stop, it can take 1 to 2mn while starting it is nearly instant. While stopping, I have a process which is eating 100% CPU time on one of my CPU cores, as soon as this process stops, the VEs stops and everything is running normal, no impact on my other VEs.

Here is the blocking process : `sulogin -t 10 /dev/console`

What is it used for ?

Any idea on how I can fix this ?
