> More to say, as you can see from [1], vzpkg and vzyum are  
> unsupported/unmaintained. Users are expected to use  
> precreated templates available from [2]. If you are  
> not satisfied with available precreated template, you can  
> repack those, or create your own from scratch.  
> There are some articles on wiki that tells you how to do that,  
> see [3].

The neat thing is that your [3] link refers to using vzpkg, which is useless as you say.

At one point there was an excellent utility called vzpkg2 which solved the problems with vzpkg. Alas, it seems to have disappeared. I still use it.
