BTW, some more details about my IO hardware: the server uses hardware RAID-10 with BBU. Initially Percona was running using O\_DIRECT for InnoDB flushing but then I switched to the default flushing mode and IO numbers became somewhat better... However after this I got several data corruptions and simply stopped any further experiments.
