My container startup is in interactive mode ... How to answer to it?

Here is the container log:

raidautorun: failed to open /dev/md0: Operation not permitted

awk: cmd. line:1: fatal: cannot open file '/proc/misc' for reading (No such file or directory)

Mounting local filesystems: [ OK ]

ng /etc/fstab swaps: [ OK ]
INIT: Entering runlevel: 3
Entering interactive startup

Start service iscsid (Y)es/(N)o/(C)ontinue? [Y]

I'd try to start it with --wait, but it do not give the chance to answer to the interactive startup ...

# vzctl start 101 --wait

. . .

File resolv.conf was modified Setting quota ugidlimit: 0 Container start in progress, waiting ...

I try "vzctl enter 101" but it does not work:

# vzctl enter 101 enter into CT 101 failed

Unable to open pty: No such file or directory

Have you got an idea? Should the only solution is to destroy the VM?
