Hi!

Almost a month ago (on April 4th) I had posted a message [1] to Discussion thread on OpenVZ forum but I still haven't got reply. So I am trying to ask in OpenVZ mail list.

Is there any way to specify a location for os templates? The default one is written in /etc/vz/vz.conf as
template=/vz/template

but I would like to have a possibility to specify the custom one e.g. with absolute path:

```
$ vzctl create --ostemplate /vz/tmp/centos-5-x86.tar.gz <CTID>
```

with corresponding value for ostemplate variable in VE config:
ostemplate="/vz/tmp/centos-5-x86.tar.gz"

I think that way would provide more flexibility.

Should I submit a feature request on that?
