Why such a feature would be needed? Is that a problem to put a tarball (or just a symlink) to /vz/template/cache?

- > with corresponding value for ostemplate variable in VE config:
- > ostemplate="/vz/tmpl/centos-5-x86.tar.gz"

This will definitely break the /etc/vz/dists/\* logic of choosing proper distscripts.

> I think that way would provide more flexibility.

There are infinite ways to provide more flexibility for vzctl -- the question is which ones are worth implementing.

Maybe you have some specific use case for such feature -- please share the scenario with us.
