Hi!

I am trying to migrate a VM from one remote node to another one but invoking vzmigrate command from third machine (front-end). Something like

```
[front-end]$ ssh <remote_host_1> sudo /usr/sbin/vzmigrate --online
```

```
<remote_host_2><CTID>
```

But I am getting the following error when executing the command below as unprivileged user with permissions in /etc/sudoers file to run

```
/usr/sbin/vz* scripts:
```

```
[front-end]$ ssh <remote_host_1> sudo /usr/sbin/vzmigrate --online
```

```
<remote_host_2><CTID>
```

```

In 312 line of /usr/sbin/vzmigrate file the vzctl is invoked as

```
[...]
```

```
get_status $($VZCTL status $VEID)
```

```
[...]
```

and VZCTL is defined in the beginning of that file as

```
VZCTL=vzctl
```

I wonder if there is any reason to define VZCTL as vzctl but not with absolute path to it (i.e. /usr/sbin/vzctl)?

Adding /usr/sbin to \$PATH in ~oneadmin/.bashrc making the following command works

```
$ ssh <remote_hosts_1[2]>"which vzctl"
```

```

but vzmigrate still fails with the error message listed above.

Any thoughts,hints,ideas on that issue?
