- > "For benchs inside real 'guest' nodes (OpenVZ/VServer) you should
- > take into account that the FS tested is not the 'host' node one's."

>

- > at least for Linux-VServer it should not be hard to avoid the
- > chroot/filesystem namespace part and have it run on the host fs.
- > a bind mount into the guest might do the trick too, if you need
- > help to accomplish that, just let me know ...

For the moment I just use the chcontext command to get rid of filesystem part. But even if the tested filesystem is not the host filesystem, I just keep in mind that all applications running inside a 'guest' will use \_this\_ filesystem and not the host one.

>From what I understand about VServer, it looks flexible enougth to let us test different 'virtualisation' parts. A 'guest' looks like a stack of different 'virtualisation' layers (chcontext + ipv4root + chroot). But it's not the case for all solutions.
