Quote:I can't tell what's wrong because my only option is to have the server wiped so I can start again.

Why would you need to wipe the server, just boot your previous kernel. I'm sure your user support could do that for you...

Also, after finishing the OpenVZ install and before rebooting, check your `/boot/grub/grub.conf`. If you google a bit, you'll find ways to reboot into a certain kernel just once, after another reset, the server will boot into another kernel again. That will eliminate the need to wipe out the server even if your support won't choose the kernel for you.

Without knowing what's the error, there really isn't much to go on. Perhaps you have some hardware that isn't supported by the OpenVZ kernel? Is your server running a stock CentOS kernel otherwise?
