So I got 4 HDD, and I want don't want LVM or Raid them (I want each one separate). I am also using Solusvm. This is for 1 user per HDD

So far, I think I have an idea, but I am not sure if it will work:

1. I make 4 different directories. /home1 /home2/ /home3/ /home4

2. I mount each directory:

```
mount /dev/sda /home1
```

```
mount /dev/sdb /home2
```

etc..

3. I bind them:

```
mount --bind /home1 /vz/root/100
```

```
mount --bind /home2 /vz/root/101
```

etc..

4. I make a bind script:

```
cat /etc/vz/conf/100.mount
```

```
#!/bin/bash
```

```
source /etc/vz/vz.conf
```

```
source ${VE_CONFFILE}
```

```
mount -n --bind /home1 ${VE_ROOT}/mnt/disk
```

Am I on the right track?
